

STUDENT DESIGNED INTERDISCIPLINARY MAJOR

All proposals must be submitted to the faculty supervisor, typed and in final form.

GENERAL PROCEDURE

1. The student, with the assistance of the faculty supervisor, will follow the procedure below:
 - a. Write a rationale for the student designed interdisciplinary major. This rationale will include a statement of the student's interests and how they can be better served by an interdisciplinary major than a traditional major, and demonstrate how the proposed major coheres.
 - b. Once the student and faculty supervisor have agreed upon course selection and rationale and both have signed the form, the student will obtain the signatures of the relevant department chairs;
 - c. After obtaining all of the above signatures, the student will submit the form and the rationale to the Registrar's Office.
2. The faculty supervisor will serve as the student's academic advisor and will:
 - a. Assist the student with the written rationale and course selections.
 - b. Assure that the form is complete and accurate.
 - c. Plan for and monitor the completion of WAC, TAC, and ILAC requirements.
 - d. Sign the completed form once course selection and rationale are approved.
3. The student, in consultation with the faculty supervisor, will designate the departments in which the WAC, TAC, and ILAC requirements will be fulfilled.
4. The student designed interdisciplinary major proposal must be approved by the Curriculum Policies Committee and the faculty. Any subsequent changes in the course listings must also be approved by the Curriculum Policies Committee.
