Art Talent Achievement Awards are up to \$4,000 per year and are renewable for up to four years while you are a full-time student at Morningside. Admitted students provide portfolios for faculty to evaluate in the areas of Studio Art, Graphic Design, Photography, or Art Education. We request you provide 12 to 20 pieces of original work, digital images or slides for your portfolio. We will not keep your pieces.

Our art department offers:

- Professors who are practicing artists.
- Studios, equipment, computer labs, and darkrooms.
- Tailor-made programs that fit your interests and goals.
- A warm, personal learning environment that encourages creativity, emotional expression and effective communication.

What makes the program special?

- Students choose from four majors: studio art, graphic design, photography or art education.
- The curriculum combines new technologies with traditional methods.
- Students develop and strengthen visual creativity by relating liberal arts studies to their area of specialization.
- Advanced studies courses offer one-on-one instruction.
- Faculty members and guest lecturers are professional artists and lead by example.
- Students enjoy small classes, one-on-one advising, personal support, guidance and critiques, and easy access to equipment and studios.
- Students demonstrate mastery of their media through their senior project/thesis.
- On-campus workshops and field trips to museums in major cities and location shoots (photography) bring classroom study to life.

What facilities and equipment do we offer?

- The Eugene C. Eppley Fine Arts Building is one of the region's finest art and music facilities.
- The Helen Levitt Art Gallery and Eppley Art Gallery feature frequent exhibitions by guest artists, faculty and students.
- Morningside's permanent collection of contemporary art includes work by artists Tamayo, Rauschenberg, Johns, Frankenthaler, Nevelson, Motherwell, Miro and Hockney.
- The MacCollin Classroom Building houses offices, classrooms, darkrooms, computer labs and eight large art studios.
- Our photography equipment is comparable to that found in many professional studios. It includes multi-format cameras (from 35 mm to large format), color and black-and-white darkrooms and processing facilities, digital cameras and related software.
- Our computer lab is equipped with the latest software for print, Web design and multimedia production.
