On Education

- **50% RATE FAIR OR POOR** the amount of state funding Iowa allocates to its public schools.
- **43% RATE GOOD, VERY GOOD, OR EXCELLENT** the amount of state funding Iowa allocates to its public schools.
- **49% DISAGREE OR STRONGLY DISAGREE** with giving parents the option to use K-12 public funding for private school; 14% neither disagree or agree.
- **35% AGREE OR STRONGLY AGREE** that parents should be able to use K-12 public funding for private school; 14% neither disagree or agree.

★ **60% SAY NO**
34% SAY YES

Regarding the economic impact of tariffs:

★ **38% SAY TARIFFS HURT**

About the Poll

The poll was completed by the Colonel Bud Day Center for Civic Engagement Jan. 17 - 23, 2020. A total of 864 Iowa adults participated with a sampling margin of error (MOE) +/- 3.3 (95% confidence level). Of those surveyed, 405 were completed by landline and 459 by cell phone via computer-assisted telephone interviews (CATI). Percentage totals may not equal 100 due to rounding.
