



## **Visual and Performing Arts CODA Legacy Award**

### **AWARD NAME**

The term coda is defined as a concluding event or remark, and the letters in this particular award produce the acronym “Culmination of Distinguished Achievement.”

### **SELECTION PROCESS, RECIPIENT NOTIFICATION, AND AWARD PRESENTATION**

May 1            Nominations are due to the CODA Award committee, and the review and selection process begins. During this time, input from additional Visual and Performing Arts faculty members will be received, and suggested recipients passed along for presidential approval. The selection committee will make their final selections.

June 1            Recipients are notified

August 1        Recipients are announced

CODA Legacy Award recipients will be honored at the annual Visual and Performing Arts Alumni Luncheon during Homecoming Weekend. Each recipient will receive an engraved plaque in honor of their valuable contribution to the Morningside University Visual and Performing Arts. A display with CODA Award recipients is located in the Eppley Auditorium Lobby.

### **NOMINATIONS**

Nominations may be submitted by alumni via the Visual and Performing Arts webpage. Members of the selection committee may also make nominations after diligent research. All nominations will be considered if the minimum selection criterion is met and will be recorded and held on file for future years.

### **RECIPIENTS**

Recipients will be selected each year from the areas of Art, Band, Choir, Orchestra, and Theatre. The number of recipients may vary from year-to-year but should not exceed six (6).
