SELECTION CRITERION

ALUMNI

- Candidate eligibility and qualifications:
 - Graduated from Morningside College and demonstrated academic and performance excellence during their tenure
 - 20 years removed from Morningside graduation year. (Exception: In select instances, this rule may be overturned by a committee vote.)
 - Demonstrates unusually high leadership, excellence, and service within their respective area in the Visual or Performing Arts
 - Demonstrates significant contributions to their respective field on a local, regional, and/or national level
 - Serves as a positive ambassador for the college and embodies the Morningside mission statement emphasizing the importance of lifelong learning, ethical leadership, and civic responsibility
 - May be inducted posthumously

FACULTY & STAFF

- Candidate eligibility and qualifications
 - Demonstrated outstanding service to the Visual and Performing Arts at Morningside College by advancing their respective area of expertise
 - Highly committed to fostering student learning and success, and well-respected among colleagues, staff, students, and administration
 - Served as a positive ambassador for the college and embodied the Morningside mission statement emphasizing the importance of lifelong learning, ethical leadership, and civic responsibility
 - Formed a regional and/or national reputation in their respective area in the visual and performing arts
 - May be awarded to retired faculty and staff members, as well as those who have moved on in their career. In addition, the nominee may be inducted posthumously.
