



COLOR GUARD TALENT GRANT - \$5,000

Morningside offers prospective students who designate Color Guard as their primary participation area a \$5,000 talent grant. This award requires an informal audition completed during a campus visit or through a submitted video recording. For the audition, students may present a solo performance (rehearsal) or excerpts demonstrating their technical and performance skills, or submit video from a high school or independent color guard ensemble. The grant is renewable each year the student is registered for and actively participates in the Pride of Morningside Marching Band. SECONDARY AREA MUSIC TALENT GRANT - \$500

While prospective students may receive a primary grant for another interest area, they may also receive an additional \$500 per year grant to participate in color guard. This award requires an informal audition completed during a campus visit or through a submitted video recording. For the audition, students may present a solo performance (rehearsal) or excerpts demonstrating their technical and performance skills, or submit video from a high school or independent color guard ensemble.
