

## 2026-2027 Freshmen Financial Aid Overview

## **ACCESS TO MSIDE BASE AWARD - EVERY STUDENT QUALIFIES**

All first-time, full-time undergraduate students admitted for the 2026-2027 academic year will automatically receive a minimum award package of scholarships and grants totaling:

STUDENT TYPE	AWARD	COMMUTER AWARD
Standard Eligibility	\$26,000/year	\$20,000/year
Nebraska or South Dakota + Pell Eligible	\$35,000/year	\$29,000/year
Iowa + Pell Eligible	\$39,000/year	\$33,000/year

These amounts represent the minimum awards, made up by your academic scholarship, talent grant (if applicable), visit grant, and all additional Federal, State, and Morningside grants. Each student's qualifications will be assessed to ensure they receive the base scholarship and grant amounts.

#### VISIT GRANT - \$1,000 per year/\$4,000 total

#### **TALENT GRANT**

When you apply to Morningside, identify your talent so we can help you set up an audition that will determine your exact award amount. Talent grants are contingent upon participation. Students can receive one talent grant up to \$5,000 and an additional \$500 in a secondary talent. Areas include:

## All About the FAFSA

Maximize your financial opportunities with the FAFSA. Many families miss out on aid by assuming they won't qualify—don't make that mistake. Completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) helps you understand the financial resources available to you.

#### **Key Details for FAFSA:**

- The 2026-2027 FAFSA will be available starting October 1, 2025
- · Visit studentaid.gov to apply
- Use Morningside's Federal School Code: 001879

#### **Understanding Financial Aid Options**

#### Federal Pell Grant - Up to \$7,395/year

 Available to students with a Student Aid Index (SAI) of \$6,655 or less

#### Federal SEOG Grant

- Supplements the Pell Grant
- · Amount varies by need and availability

#### Iowa Tuition Grant - Up to \$7,500/year

Requirements:

- · Must be an Iowa resident
- FAFSA deadline July 1
- SAI must be \$16,000 or less

#### **Morningside Grant/Achievement Grant**

· Award varies based on need and other aid

#### Federal Teach Grant - Up to \$4,000/year

Requirements:

- Minimum GPA of 3.25 or 75th percentile on any ACT subscore
- Commit to teach full-time in a high-need field at a low-income school for four to eight years following graduation

**Note:** If requirements are not met, the grant converts to a loan

#### **Federal Work Study**

- · Award varies based on need and other aid
- Typical award: \$2,000/year

#### Federal Stafford Loan

Subsidized: No interest while in school; 6.39% fixed rate

Unsubsidized: Accrues interest while in school; 6.39% fixed rate

#### Repayment begins six months after graduation

Year in School	Loan Amount
Freshman	up to \$5,500
Sophomore	up to \$6,500
Junior/Senior	up to \$7,500

Federal, state, and private grants/scholarships in combination with institutional funding should not exceed tuition, fees, housing, and food. If necessary, institutional funding will be reduced.

Students who enrolled in college AFTER high school and have completed 27 transferable credits, should refer to the Transfer students section at morningside.edu. Students can not qualify for both Freshman and Transfer awards.

\*Students must meet all qualifications found at morningside.edu/accesstomside. Online students and St. Luke's College students are not eligible for these programs. The Office of Student Financial Planning encourages students to complete the FAFSA each year to fully understand your aid options and to receive a comprehensive award picture. Access to Mside and Siouxland Proud, Mside Bound students must complete the FAFSA annually by July 1st to ensure they remain eligible for these programs. These programs ensure that you will receive, at a minimum, the same dollar amount in Morningside grants and scholarship assistance toward tuition as in your first year for the entirety of your program, as long as you maintain good academic standing, enroll full-time, complete any required documentation by specified deadlines, and continue to live on campus. However, if tuition increases in future years or if you do not qualify for Federal Pell Grants or lowa Tuition Grants in subsequent years, you will be responsible for covering the additional costs.

All Students who are approved and choose to live off-campus before reaching 91 credits will have their financial aid reduced by \$6,000/year.

- Federal Parent PLUS Loan: Fixed interest rate of 8.94%
- **Private Loans:** May require a co-signer
- Morningside Interest-Free Payment Plans:
  - 10-month interest-free plan
  - 8-month interest-free plan
  - Flexible custom payment plans available
