Morningside University's Senior Scholar Program is designed for Seniors who reside in Nebraska or South Dakota and wish to take courses at the college level.

PROVISIONS OF THE MORNINGSIDE UNIVERSITY SENIOR SCHOLAR PROGRAM:

1. Student must be a high school senior and verify a cumulative 3.0 GPA on a 4.0
2. Student may register for up to 8 credits in the Fall and 8 credits in the Spring.
3. Applicants must pay a \$50 processing fee at the time of registration.
4. Music private lessons are excluded from the Senior Scholar program.
5. Applicants may purchase books at the bookstore and may charge them to their student account. All course fees (art, travel, etc.) will be billed to the student account.
6. Students must arrange a registration appointment with the Advising & Disability Services Coordinator before their registration will be considered complete.
